Heat Treatment Preparation List

Most important prepping:

- ** Bag all clothes from dressers and closets – fill trash bags ½ full and leave in rooms**
- ** Bag bedding in ½ full trash bags and leave in rooms**
- ** Ensure facility is clean!! Less clutter better results! If there are items you no longer need now is the time to “spring clean”. Do not leave clothing and similar items on the floor.**
- ** Remove vinyl mini-blinds**

Common Items that Should be Removed:

- LCD/Plasma & flat screen items (tv's, laptops, tablets)
- Wax Candles
- Living Plants
- Art Supplies
- Medicines
- All Fresh Foods, Wines, Liquors, etc. (put in the refrigerator)
- Smoke Alarm Batteries/Smoke Alarms (If possible)
- Oil Paintings
- Fire Extinguishers
- Plastic Exit Signs
- Smoke Detectors
- Plastic Air-conditioning Face Plate (window units)
- Lipstick (other cosmetics that may melt)
- Batteries
- Pressurized Cans (Hairspray)
- Lighters, lighter fluid
- Pressurized Cleaning Products
- Any items of personal value that you are hesitant about please remove (family heirlooms, trophies, crystals, etc.)

Areas That May Need Addressed

- Unplug Refrigerator (Keep compressor from overheating) – technician will do this
- Sprinkler Heads Set to 185F
- Have Water Faucets on Slightly – technician will do this
- Laminate Furniture
- Move Furniture away from Walls – technician will do this
- Remove Outlet Covers/Switch Plates (allows for heat to penetrate into the walls) – in extremely infested rooms.
- Ensure facility is clean. If you have vacuumed take the bag out to a dumpster in a sealed plastic bag. Do not use vacuum again until bag is changed.
